Jesus Is God and Cares about Me!

Welcome to the first day of our 2022 Vacation Bible School! We are so happy that you could join us to learn how Jesus does the impossible!

Sometimes, we find ourselves lacking what we need. We need outside help to save us from shame and ridicule. We don't know where to turn. We need to be treated with grace.

Jesus cares for us, not just giving the bare minimum, but by blessing us with an abundance of the best things. In His grace, Jesus blesses us with far more than we expect or deserve. He points us to Himself, the Son of God.

While attending a wedding feast, Jesus' mother informs Him the wine is gone and asks Him to help.

In that culture, hospitality was extremely important. Running out of wine would have been embarrassing and shameful for the newlywed couple.

Jesus turns water into an abundance of the best wine you can imagine. This is Jesus' first sign, which points to His identity as the Son of God.

Jesus' First Miracle (John 2:1-12)

Today we're going to examine a Bible story about Jesus' first miracle.

There was a wedding in the town of Cana in Galilee. Jesus, His disciples, and His mother, Mary, were there. They were all happy for the bride and groom.

But then something went very wrong. They were out of wine! Mary knew this would be so embarrassing for the bride and groom.

She called Jesus to her and told Him there was no more wine. Jesus looked at His mom and said, "My time hasn't come yet!"

So Mary went to the kitchen where the servants were gathered. She told them, "Do whatever Jesus tells you to do!"

When the time was right, Jesus pointed


to six big containers. Each one could hold twenty or thirty gallons! He said, "Fill those up with water." The servants filled them all the way to the top and carried them back to Jesus.

Jesus told one servant to take a cup of the water to the Master. The Master tasted what was in the cup. He said, "This is amazing!" The Master took the cup to the groom. He said, "This is the best wine ever!" Usually, people served the best, most expensive wine first and saved the less tasty wine for later in the night. The groom said, "I thought we ran out of wine!"

What Jesus had done was the first of many impossible things He would do to reveal His glory. The disciples knew what happened, and they believed in Him.
