him in newness of life.

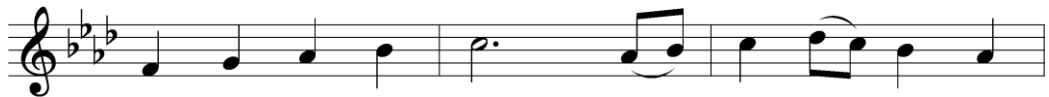
